


General Fund Budget

- No General Fund Millage since 1998
- Expenditures up 7.86%
 - Departments Admin, Police, Building & Codes, Parks and Recreation & Roads – new employees, increased police expenditures, increase in code expenditures and increase in legal fees.
- ☐ Revenues up 2.57%
 - As we have done every year, we have conservatively budgeted RE Transfer Tax and EIT, the largest revenue items.
 - Expenditures in excess of Revenues before transfers in the amount of \$683,750.
- Fund Balance will be a healthy \$4,461,050 at the end of 2026.

General Fund Expenditures \$14,190,900



Our Millage vs. Surrounding Municipalities*




Real Estate Tax Millage Pie
